ROAD TRAFFIC

The A259 Trunk Road (Barnhorn Road) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2013

Made - - - - - *25th February 2013*

Coming into force - - - - - *16th March 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed on and near the road:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Barnhorn Road) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 16th March 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road (Barnhorn Road) in the County of East Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between points 80 metres east of the centre of its junction at Middle Bridge and 355 metres east of the centre of its junction with Green Lane;

“works” mean junction improvement work on and near the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 18th March 2013 or on any subsequent day until 15th September 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

(a) 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed; or

(b) 40 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that length of road are not displayed.

5. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation
