**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A249 Trunk Road (Kingsferry Junction – Cowstead Corner Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - 28th April 2014

*Coming into force* - - 17th May 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A249 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A249 Trunk Road (Kingsferry Junction – Cowstead Corner Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 17th May 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A249 Trunk Road in the County of Kent;

“ the northbound carriageway” means the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from its junction with the road leading to Old Ferry Road and Sheppey Way at Kingsferry junction to the Cowstead roundabout (A249/A2500);

“the southbound carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road from Cowstead Corner roundabout (A2500) to its junction with the road leading from Old Ferry Road and Sheppey Way at Kingsferry junction;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing and all associated works on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 19th May 2014 or on any subsequent weekday until 16th November 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northbound carriageway or the southbound carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
