ROAD TRAFFIC

The M62 Motorway (Junction 21 Eastbound Exit Slip Road and Designated Exit Slip Road to the A6193 Sir Isaac Newton Way) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *2nd May 2014*
Coming into force - - *5th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those slip roads in the District of Rochdale in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Junction 21 Eastbound Exit Slip Road and Designated Exit Slip Road to the A6193 Sir Isaac Newton Way) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 5th May 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M62 Motorway at Junction 21;

“works” means re-cabling and maintenance works on the motorway slip roads;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2000 hours and 0500 hours (continuing to 0700 hours on Saturday and Sunday mornings) during a period starting on Tuesday 6 May 2014 and ending on Friday 30 May 2014. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 21;

“the designated slip road” means the designated exit slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 21 to the A6193 Sir Isaac Newton Way.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road or the designated slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
