**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A49 Trunk Road (Holmer, Herefordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made - - - - 19th May 2014*

*Coming into force - - 26th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road at Holmer, in the County of Herefordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Holmer, Herefordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 26th May 2014.

2. In this Order –

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period" means the period starting at 22:30 hours on Monday 2nd June 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby situated adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A49 approximately 230 metres north of its roundabout junction with the A4103 Roman Road (Starting Gate Roundabout).

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the northbound or southbound carriageways of the A49 at its junction with Church Way.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- c) being used in connection with the said works; or
- d) proceeding to and from premises which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
