**The A590 Trunk Road (Newlands) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed
Limit) Order 2014**

16th June 2014

Coming into force

27th June 2014

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and (2), of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order on the A590 Trunk Road in the District of South Lakeland in the County of Cumbria:

1. This Order may be cited as The A590 Trunk Road (Newlands) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 27th June 2014.
2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A590 Trunk Road from a point 32 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Tebay Lane, to a point 60 metres west of the western bull nose of the kerbed island of the Arrad Foot dual carriageway section of the A590 Trunk Road.
3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the trunk road;
4. Nothing in article 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services.
5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 (b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
