**The A5 and A38 Trunk Roads and the M6 Toll Motorway
(Weeford, Staffordshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic)
Order 2014**

Made - - - - *8th September 2014*
Coming into force - - *15th September 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), the M6 Toll Motorway (“the M6 Toll”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length the A5, and five of those connecting roads, at Weeford in the County of Staffordshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 and A38 Trunk Roads and the M6 Toll Motorway (Weeford, Staffordshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 15th September 2014.

2. In this Order –

“Weeford Island” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A5, A38 and the M6 Toll at Weeford;

“the trunk road” means the eastbound carriageway of the A5 from a point 0.1 kilometres from Weeford Island, to a point 300 metres east of the centreline of Flats Lane overbridge also known as Packington Moor overbridge;

“a slip road” means the slip roads leading to Weeford Island from –
a) the southbound carriageway of the A38;
b) the westbound carriageway of the A5;
c) the northbound carriageway of the A38;
d) the eastbound carriageway of the A5; and
e) the M6 Toll (Junction T4);

"the works period"

means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 22nd September 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the trunk road, a slip road or Weeford Island.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- a. being used for special forces purposes;
- b. being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- c. proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
