**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M27 Motorway (Junctions 11 - 9) (Temporary Prohibition  
of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - - *15th September 2014*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *4th October 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M27 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that motorway and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M27 Motorway (Junctions 11 - 9) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 4th October 2014.

**2.** In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M27 Motorway in the County of Hampshire;

“the length of carriageway” means the westbound carriageway of the motorway between the tip of the nosing of the ‘off’ slip road at Junction 11 (A27) and the tip of the nosing of the ‘on’ slip road at Junction 9 (A27);

“a slip road means –

(i) the road leading to the westbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 11 (A27), or

(ii) the road leading from the westbound carriageways of the motorway at Junction 9 (A27);

“the link road” means the road leading from the westbound carriageway of the motorway to the northbound carriageway of the A32 at Junction 10 of the motorway;

“works” mean carriageway inlay resurfacing over the bridge deck and associated structural works; routine motorway maintenance and all associated work;

“a works period” means a period of 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 6th October 2014 or on any subsequent day until 3rd April 2016.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway, the link road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
