**The M56 Motorway (Junction 10 Westbound and Eastbound
Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2014**

Made - - - - *10th September 2014*
Coming into force - - *14th September 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M56 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those slip roads in the District of Warrington should be prohibited because works by Warrington Borough Council are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M56 Motorway (Junction 10 Westbound and Eastbound Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 14th September 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M56 Motorway at Junction 10;

“works” means resurfacing works on the roundabout over the motorway by Warrington Borough Council;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2100 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 15th September 2014 and ending on Saturday 4th October 2014. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the first slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 10;

“the second slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 10;

“the third slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 10;

“the fourth slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 10.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first, second, third and fourth slip roads.
4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
