ROAD TRAFFIC

The A52 Trunk Road (Nottingham) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - - *27th October 2014*

Coming into force - - - - - *3rd November 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads, in the City of Nottingham, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Nottingham) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 3rd November 2014.

2. In this Order –

“Queens Drive Island” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction with the A52, A453 Queens Drive and Lenton Lane;

“a slip road” means the slip roads leading –
a) to the northbound carriageway of the A52 from Queens Drive Island; and
b) from the northbound carriageway of the A52 to its junction with Redfield Road;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right.

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Sunday 9th November 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed.

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the laybys adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A52 situated –

- a) 75 metres north of Queens Drive Island; and
- b) 560 metres north of Queens Drive Island.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- a) being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance purposes;
- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- c) being used in connection with the said works
