**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A12 Trunk Road (St Peters Street to Station Square,  
Lowestoft, Suffolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order  
2014**

*Made* - - - - *20th October 2014*

*Coming into force* - - *27th October 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (“the A12”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Lowestoft in the County of Suffolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(a)</sup> hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (St Peters Street to Station Square, Lowestoft, Suffolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 27th October 2014.

2. In this Order –

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing, renewal of road markings and traffic signal loops, levelling of ironworks and routine maintenance;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 3rd November 2014 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or Sunday) until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A12 at Lowestoft between its junctions with the A1144 St Peters Street/Jubilee Way Roundabout and Waveney Road/Station Square.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used for or in connection with the works or for winter maintenance,
- (b) being used for, police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a police constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, or

(d) proceeding to or from properties which are accessible from, and only from, the A12.
