ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 36 Nine Mile Hill,
Cambridgeshire) Westbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *6th January 2014*

Coming into force - - *13th January 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 36 Nine Mile Hill, Cambridgeshire) Westbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 13th January 2014.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 20th January 2014, or on any subsequent day until works to replace bridge joints on the A11 Cambridge Road overbridge been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the entry slip road to the westbound carriageway of the A14 at Junction 36 Nine Mile Hill.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or winter maintenance purposes.
