**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation
Display Teams) (No. 2) Regulations 2014**

Made - - - - *11th March 2014*

Coming into force - - *19th March 2014*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of the places specified in column 1 of the Table in the Schedule by reason of the intended holding of flying display rehearsals by a jet formation display team on 19th and 20th March 2014.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 2) Regulations 2014 and come into force on 19th March 2014.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 0800 hours and 2000 hours no aircraft is to fly at the places specified in column 1 of the Table in the Schedule within the area specified for each such place and bounded by a circle having a radius of 6 nautical miles whose centre is at the point specified in column 2 of the Table, below the altitude and on the day specified, respectively, in columns 3 and 4 of the Table.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying within controlled airspace or within an aerodrome traffic zone in respect of which there is an appropriate air traffic control unit^(b) if it flies in accordance with a clearance or permission of the unit controlling that airspace or zone.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in the locations and airspace specified in the Schedule during flying display rehearsals by the Royal Air Force Aerobatic Team, The Red Arrows, which are due to take place on 19th and 20th March 2014.

In order to protect the display aircraft and other air traffic, the Civil Aviation Authority considers that access by other aircraft to the airspace within which the display team will rehearse should be restricted for reasons of public safety. This has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

Full details of the restrictions will be promulgated by NOTAM (being a Notice to Airmen published by the Civil Aviation Authority to industry).
