**The A46 Trunk Road (Glenfield, Leicestershire) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015**

Made - - - - 13th February 2015

Coming into force - - 20th February 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and the connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads, at Glenfield in the County of Leicestershire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Glenfield, Leicestershire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Friday 20th February 2015.

2. In this Order –

“M1 Junction 21a Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A46 and the slip roads leading to and from the M1 at Junction 21a;

“the trunk road” means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A46 between the M1 Junction 21a Roundabout, and the roundabout junction with the B5380 Ratby Road and Kirby Road;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A46 to the M1 Junction 21a Roundabout;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Wednesday 25th February 2015 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

- a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –
 - i. being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - ii. proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and
- c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by, or with the permission of, a traffic officer in uniform.
