**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation  
Display Teams) (No. 3) (Amendment) Regulations 2016**

*Made* - - - - *11th May 2016*

*Coming into force* - - *4th June 2016*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying by reason of the holding of flying displays by a jet formation display team.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009<sup>(a)</sup>.

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 3) (Amendment) Regulations 2016 and come into force on 4th June 2016.

**Amendment**

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 3) Regulations 2016<sup>(b)</sup> are amended as follows.

3. In column 2 of the Schedule, in respect of the entry for Arbroath, for “563307N 0023459W” substitute “563341N 0023333W”.

4. In column 4 of the Schedule, in respect of the entry for Silverstone, for “9 July 2016” substitute “10 July 2016”.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 3) Regulations 2016 (S.I. 2016/346). The amendment amends the location of the flying restrictions for the display at Arbroath that is scheduled to take place on 4th June 2016 and the date of the flying restrictions for the display at Silverstone that was scheduled to take place on 9th July 2016.

Full details of the amendment will be promulgated by NOTAM.
