**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Leeds East Airport)
(Revocation) Regulations 2016**

Made - - - - *19th May 2016*

Coming into force - - *20th May 2016*

The Secretary of State previously decided that it was necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Leeds East Airport, Yorkshire, by reason of the holding of The Great Yorkshire Airfest.

That airshow having now been cancelled, the Secretary of State no longer considers it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in that area and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Leeds East Airport) (Revocation) Regulations 2016 and come into force on 20th May 2016.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The following Regulations are revoked—

- (a) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Leeds East Airport) Regulations 2016(b), and
- (b) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Leeds East Airport) (Amendment) Regulations 2016(c).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations revoke the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Leeds East Airport) Regulations 2016 ((S.I. 2016/522) and the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Leeds East Airport) (Amendment) Regulations 2016 (S.I. 2016/581), which imposed restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Leeds East Airport on the 2nd and 3rd July 2016, as a result of The Great Yorkshire Airfest 2016 having been cancelled.
