**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southport)
(Amendment) Regulations 2016**

Made - - - - - *9th August 2016*

Coming into force - - - *9th September 2016*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Southport, Merseyside, by reason of the holding of the Southport Air Show.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southport) (Amendment) Regulations 2016 and come into force on 9th September 2016.

Amendment

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southport) Regulations 2016(b) are amended as follows.

3. In regulation 3(2)(a), for “1600” substitute “1930”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southport) Regulations 2016 (S.I. 2016/734). The amendment changes the time of the restriction on flying in the specified airspace on 9th September 2016 for the Southport Air Show taking place at Southport, Merseyside.

Full details of the amendment will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
