The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday Flypast) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2018

Made - - - - *6th June 2018*

Coming into force - - *9th June 2018*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Suffolk, Essex, Greater London, Buckinghamshire and Oxfordshire by reason of the intended holding of a large formation flypast of aircraft to commemorate Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday Flypast) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2018 and come into force on 9th June 2018.

Amendment

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday Flypast) Regulations 2018^(b) are amended as follows—

- (a) in regulation 3(10)(b), after "Centre", add "or Royal Air Force (Unit) Swanwick", and
- (b) in regulation 3(11)(a), after paragraph (ii) insert "(iii) the air traffic control unit at Farnborough aerodrome, or (iv) Royal Air Force (Unit) Swanwick, or".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday Flypast) Regulations (S.I 2018/361).

The amendment inserts the air traffic control units at Royal Air Force (Unit) Swanwick and at Farnborough aerodrome to the units authorised to give clearance within the airspace over their control.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular (AIC) and Notice To Airmen (NOTAM).
