The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2021

Made - - - - *10th August 2021*

Coming into force - - *14th August 2021*

The Secretary of State has previously decided that it is in the public interest to restrict flying by reason of the intended holding of flying displays by a jet formation display team.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2021 and they come into force on 14th August 2021.

Amendment

2.—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) Regulations 2021^(b) are amended as follows.

(2) In the Schedule, insert the following entries in the respective columns—

““Odiham	511419N 0005641W	5,500 feet	14th August 2021”,
“Isle of Wight	504229N 0011714W	5,500 feet	16th September 2021”, and
“Duxford	520532N 0000750E	8,200 feet	18th and 19th September 2021””.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) Regulations 2021 (S.I. 2021/536, as amended by S.I. 2021/655) which restrict flying in the vicinity of places where jet formation display teams intend to give flying displays.

The Regulations add displays to be held at Odiham (14th August 2021), the Isle of Wight (16th September 2021), and at Duxford (18th and 19th September 2021).

Full details of the amendment will be promulgated by Notice to Aviation (NOTAM).
