**The A487 Trunk Road (Penglais
Road, Aberystwyth, Ceredigion)
(40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2011**

Made *27 May 2011*

Coming into force *10 June 2011*

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the Fishguard - Bangor Trunk Road (A487) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 84 (1) and (2) and 124 of and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) (“the 1984 Act”) and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the Dyfed-Powys Police, make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on the 10 June 2011 and its title is The A487 Trunk Road (Penglais Road, Aberystwyth, Ceredigion) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2011.

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in that length of the trunk road at Penglais Road, Aberystwyth in the County of Ceredigion that extends from a point 74 metres north east of the centre point of its junction with Dan-Y-Coed to a point 86 metres east of its junction with Maeshendre.

3. The A487 Trunk Road (Penglais Road, Aberystwyth, Ceredigion) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2004(2) is hereby revoked.
