The A48 Trunk Road (Cwmffrwd Junction to Llanddarog Junction, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibitions) Order 2011

Coming into force

5 September 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the London – Fishguard Trunk Road (A48) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited and restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 5 September 2011. The title to this Order is The A48 Trunk Road (Cwmffrwd Junction to Llanddarog Junction, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibitions) Order 2011.

2.—1) In this Order:

"the lengths of the trunk road" ("y darnau o'r gefnffordd") means the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules to this Order.

"works period," ("cyfnod y gwaith") means that period commencing at 18.00 hours on 5 September 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- **3.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to turn right in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.
- **4.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.
- **5.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.
- **6.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.
- 7. The provisions of article 3, 4, 5, and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition and restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.
- **8.** The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.

SCHEDULE 2

EXTENT OF TEMPORARY 40 AND 10 MPH SPEED LIMITS AND PROHIBITION OF OVERTAKING

That length of the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from the centre-point of Cwmffrwd Junction to the centre-point of Llanddarog Junction, in the County of Carmarthenshire
