The A44 Trunk Road (Various
Locations between Llangurig and
Eisteddfa Gurig, Powys)
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions &
Prohibition) Order 2011

Made 26 September 2011

Coming into force 1 October 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Newtown – Aberystwyth Trunk Road (A44) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited by reason of works being executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 1 October 2011 and its title is The A44 Trunk Road (Various Locations between Llangurig and Eisteddfa Gurig, Powys) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions & Prohibition) Order 2011.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means those lengths of the A44 trunk road between Llangurig and Eisteddfa Gurig in the County of Powys specified in the Schedule to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 08:00 hours on 1 October 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used for emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in paras (i) to (vi) of the Schedule to this Order.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in paras (i) to (vi) of the Schedule to this Order.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in paras (i) to (vi) of the Schedule to this Order.

6. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the lengths of the trunk road, specified in paras (i) to (vi) of the Schedule to this Order, during such times as the restriction referred to in article 5 is in operation.

7. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, with a width of or exceeding 2.5 metres to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road specified in paras (iii), (iv) and (vi) of the Schedule to this Order.

8. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

9. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

- (2) By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006, these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

SCHEDULE

i) Glansevern Arms

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 230 metres east of the centre-point of the access to Swyn-y-Nant to a point 360 metres west of the centre-point of the said access.

ii) Llwyn yr Hyddod, nr. Pont-Rhydgaled

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 250 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with the U2728 to a point 275 metres west of the said junction.

iii) Pont-Rhydgaled

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 200 metres east of the centre-point of the access to Pont-Rhydgaled to a point 439 metres west of the centre-point of the said access.

iv) Six Sycamores to Nurses Corner, Pont-Rhydgaled

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 990 metres west of the centre-point of the access to Six Sycamores to a point 309 metres east of the said access.

v) Plynlimon Café

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 105 metres east of the centre-point of the access to Tyn y Cwm to a point 478 metres west of the said access.

vi) East of Llangurig Filling Station to West of Aberbidno

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 280 metres east of the centre-point of the entrance to Llangurig filling station to a point 608 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with the U2729.
