**The A494 Trunk Road (Glan-yr-Afon to Braich Du, Gwynedd)
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibition) Order 2011**

Made 07 February 2011

Coming into force 12 February 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Dolgellau-South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (A494) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”) are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon;

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (1) and of all other enabling powers (2), make this Order:

1. This Order comes into force on 1 March 2011 and its title is the A494 Trunk Road (Glan-yr-Afon to Braich Du, Gwynedd) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibition) Order 2011.

2. (1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means that length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 08:00 hours on 12 February 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph in that length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 mph in that length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in that length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule.

6. The provisions of article 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such an extent as the application of the prohibition and restrictions referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

7. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 6 months.

SCHEDULE

That length of the trunk road from a point at the centreline of its junction with the County Class 3 road number 224 at Glan-yr-Afon to a point 1,200 metres south west of the centreline of the access road to Braich Du, Glan-yr-Afon.
