ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A470 Trunk Road (Abercynon Roundabout, Rhondda Cynon Taf, to Abercanaid Roundabout, Merthyr Tydfil) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibitions) Order 2012

Made 18 September 2012

Coming into force 24 September 2012

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Cardiff – Llangurig Trunk Road (A470) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 24 September 2012. The title to this Order is The A470 Trunk Road (Abercynon Roundabout, Rhondda Cynon Taf, to Abercanaid Roundabout, Merthyr Tydfil) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibitions) Order 2012.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the lengths of the A470 trunk road between Abercynon Roundabout in the County Borough of Rhondda Cynon Taf and Abercanaid Roundabout, in the County Borough of Merthyr Tydfil specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 00.01 hours on 24 September 2012 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempti”*) means any vehicle being used for the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour, in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour, in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour, in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

6. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2, during such times as the restriction referred to in article 5 is in force.

7. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3.

Application

8. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibitions referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

9. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1

TEMPORARY 50 MPH SPEED LIMIT

That length of the northbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from a point 1470 metres south of the start of the existing permanent 50 MPH speed limit, in a northerly direction to a point at the start of the said existing 50 MPH speed limit.

SCHEDULE 2

TEMPORARY 30 MPH AND 10 MPH SPEED LIMITS AND PROHIBITION OF OVERTAKING

i) That length of the northbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from a point 550 metres south of its junction with Abercynon Roundabout to a point at its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Abercynon Roundabout.

ii) That length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from a point at its junction with Abercynon Roundabout in a southerly direction for a distance of 100 metres.

iii) That length of the northbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from a point at its junction with Abercynon Roundabout in a northerly direction for a distance of 100 metres.

iv) That length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from a point at 100 metres north of its junction with Abercynon Roundabout to a point at its junction with Abercynon Roundabout.

v) The entire length of the circulatory carriageway of Abercynon Roundabout.

SCHEDULE 3

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES

i) That length of the northbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from a point at the physical nosing of Navigation Park Junction to a point at its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Abercynon Roundabout.

ii) That length of the northbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from a point at its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Abercynon Roundabout to a point at its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Abercanaid Roundabout.

iii) That length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from a point at its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Abercanaid Roundabout to a point at its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Abercynon Roundabout.

iv) That length of the south-east quadrant of the circulatory carriageway of Abercynon Roundabout which extends from a point at its physical nosing with the A472 to a point at its physical nosing with the A470 northbound carriageway.

v) That length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road which extends from a point at its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Abercynon Roundabout to a point at its physical nosing of the southbound on slip road at Navigation Park Roundabout.
