The A487 Trunk Road (Pont ar
Dyfi, Machynlleth, Powys)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles,
Pedestrians and Cyclists) Order
2012

Made 3 February 2012

Coming into force 13 February 2012

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Fishguard – Bangor Trunk Road (A487) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 13 February 2012 and its title is The A487 Trunk Road (Pont ar Dyfi, Machynlleth, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Pedestrians and Cyclists) Order 2012.

2. —1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A487 trunk road at Pont ar Dyfi, Machynlleth in the County of Powys which extends from a point at the south end of Pont ar Dyfi, 75 metres south of its junction with the A489 and A493 to a point at the north end of Pont ar Dyfi at its junction with the said roads;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 09:00 hours on 13 February 2012 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed along the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no pedestrian shall, during the works period, proceed in the length of the trunk road.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal bicycles or tricycles in the length of the trunk road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

7. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 6 months.
