**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 10  
(Caernarfon Road Interchange) to  
Junction 9 (Treborth Interchange),  
Gwynedd) (Temporary Traffic  
Prohibitions & Restrictions) Order  
2013

*Made* 27 June 2013

*Coming into force* 3 July 2013

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Chester – Bangor Trunk Road (A55) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited or restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on the 3 July 2013. Its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 10 (Caernarfon Road Interchange) to Junction 9 (Treborth Interchange), Gwynedd) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions and Restrictions) Order 2013.

**2.**—(1) In this Order:

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- (1) 1984 c.27; Section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.
- (2) By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006, these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means those lengths of the A55 trunk road between Junction 10 (Caernarfon Road Interchange) and Junction 9 (Treborth Interchange), Gwynedd, as specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 19:00 hours on 3 July 2013 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are removed permanently.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

### **Prohibition and Restrictions**

3. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to be driven, in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden any pedal cycle in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no pedestrian shall, during the works period, proceed in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

6. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

### **Application**

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 apply only at such times and to such extent as the prohibitions and restrictions referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

8. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.

## SCHEDULES

### SCHEDULE 1

#### Temporary prohibition of vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians

That length of the westbound carriageway from the start of the nosing where the westbound off slip road diverges from the main A55 carriageway at Junction 10, Caernarfon Road Interchange to a point 200 metres west of the centrepoint of Junction 9, Treborth Interchange.

That entire length of the westbound on slip road at Junction 10, Caernarfon Road Interchange.

That entire length of the eastbound on slip road at Junction 9, Treborth Interchange.

### SCHEDULE 2

#### Temporary 40 mph speed limit

That length of westbound carriageway that extends from a point 1400 metres east of the centrepoint of Junction 10, Caernarfon Road Interchange to the centrepoint of Junction 10, Caernarfon Road Interchange.

That entire length of the westbound off slip road at Junction 10, Caernarfon Road Interchange.

That entire length of the eastbound on slip road at Junction 9, Treborth Interchange.
