**The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 11,
Llys y Gwynt to Junction 14,
Madryn, Gwynedd) (Temporary
Traffic Prohibitions and
Restrictions) Order 2013**

Made 22 July 2013

Coming into force 29 July 2013

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Chester–Bangor Trunk Road (A55) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”) are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited and restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 29 July 2013 and its title is the A55 Trunk Road (Junction 11, Llys y Gwynt to Junction 14 Madryn, Gwynedd) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions and Restrictions) Order 2013.

2. (1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means those lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing from 18.00 hours on 28 July 2013 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are removed

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions and Restrictions

3. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to make a right hand turn or U-turn from one carriageway to the other through the central reservation gaps in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3.

6. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 4.

Application

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only at such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibitions and restriction referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

8. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.

SCHEDULES

SCHEDULE 1

Prohibition of all vehicles

That length of the trunk road between Junction 11, Llys y Gwynt and Junction 13, Abergwyngregyn.

SCHEDULE 2

Prohibition of right hand turns and U-turns

That length of the trunk road between Junction 12, Talybont and Junction 13, Abergwyngregyn.

SCHEDULE 3

Limits of the 40 mph restriction

That length of the trunk road from a point at the centre of Llys y Gwynt over-bridge to a point at the centre of Madryn over-bridge.

SCHEDULE 4

Limits of the 10 mph restriction

i. That length of the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road from a point 131 metres east of the centre-point of Junction 12, Talybont splitter island to a point 3.2 km east of Junction 12, Talybont splitter island

ii. That length of the westbound carriageway of the trunk road from a point 439 metres east of the centrepoint of Junction 13, Abergwyngregyn splitter island to a point 2.6 km east of Junction 12, Talybont splitter island.
