**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 22,  
Old Colwyn to Junction 23A,  
Pensarn, Conwy) (Temporary  
Traffic Prohibitions and Restriction)  
Order 2013**

*Made* 13 September 2013

*Coming into force* 23 September 2013

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Chester – Bangor Trunk Road (A55) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited or restricted by reason of works being executed thereon.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**1.** This Order comes into force on 23 September 2013. Its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 22, Old Colwyn to Junction 23A, Pensarn, Conwy) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions and Restriction) Order 2013.

**2.** —(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the lengths of the trunk road” (*“y darnau o’r gefnffordd”*) means those lengths of the A55 trunk road between Junction 22, Old Colwyn and Junction 23A, Pensarn in the County Borough of Conwy specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 23 September 2013 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

### **Prohibitions and Restriction**

**3.** Subject to the provisions of article 9, no person shall, during the works period, drive any vehicle or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

**4.** Subject to the provisions of article 9, no person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden any pedal cycle in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

**5.** Subject to the provisions of article 9, no pedestrian shall, during the works period, proceed in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

**6.** Subject to the provisions of article 9, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

### **Suspensions**

**7.** The provisions of Regulation 13, paragraphs (1) and (2) of The Special Road (Llanddulas to Colwyn Bay) Regulations 1984(3) are suspended insofar as they apply to the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order during such times as the restriction specified in article 6 is in operation.

**8.** The provisions of Regulation 13(1) and (2) of The Special Road (Colwyn Bay to Glan Conwy) Regulations 1985(4) are suspended in respect of the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order during such times as the restriction specified in article 6 is in operation.

### **Application**

**9.** The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibitions and restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

**10.** The maximum duration of this Order shall be 12 months.

## **SCHEDULES**

### **SCHEDULE 1**

#### **Temporary prohibition of vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians**

The length of the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 200 metres east of the nosing of the eastbound on slip road at Junction 22, Old Colwyn to the centre-point of Junction 23, Llanddulas.

The length of the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 200 metres east of the nosing of the eastbound on slip road at Junction 22, Old Colwyn to the centre-point of Junction 23A, Pensarn

The entire length of the eastbound on slip road at Junction 22, Old Colwyn.

The entire length of the eastbound on slip road at Junction 23, Llanddulas.

### **SCHEDULE 2**

#### **Temporary 40 mph speed limit**

The length of the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 1.6 kilometres west of the nosing of the eastbound off slip road at Junction 22, Old Colwyn to a point 1 kilometre east of the nosing of the eastbound on slip road at Junction 23, Llanddulas.
