The A494 Trunk Road (Bala, Gwynedd) (Temporary 30 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking) Order 2014

Made 14 April 2014

Coming into force 22 April 2014

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Dolgellau – South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (A494) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 22 April 2014 and its title is The A494 Trunk Road (Bala, Gwynedd) (Temporary 30 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking) Order 2014.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means the length of the trunk road at Bala in the County of Gwynedd that extends from a point 14 metres north-east of its junction with the Class III road adjacent to the dwelling known as Rhiwlas Lodge to a point 270 metres north east of its junction with the B4401;

"restricted period" ("cyfnod y cyfyngiad") means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 22 April 2014

and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order

Restriction and Prohibition

3. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the restricted period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

4.Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the restricted period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road during such times as the restriction referred to in article 3 is in operation.

Application

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 6 months.
