The A483 Trunk Road (Junction 7,
Rossett Interchange to the
Wales/England Border, Wrexham
County Borough) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles and 40 MPH
Speed Limit) Order 2014

Made *21 August 2014*
Coming into force *1 September 2014*

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Swansea to Manchester Trunk Road (A483) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited and restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon or near to.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2) make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 1 September 2014. Its title is The A483 Trunk Road (Junction 7, Rossett Interchange to the Wales/England Border, Wrexham County Borough) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles and 40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2014.

2. (1) In this Order :

“exempted vehicle” (“cerbyd esempt”) means any vehicle being used in connection with the works giving rise to this Order and by the emergency services;

lengths of the trunk road” (“y darnau o’r gefnffordd”) means the lengths of the trunk road in the County Borough of Wrexham specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 21:00 hours on 1 September 2014 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition and Restriction

3. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

Application

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition and restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 12 months.

SCHEDULE 1

i) The length of the northbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from the start of the nosing of the northbound off slip road at Junction 7, Rossett Interchange to the Wales/England border.

ii) The length of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from the Wales/England border to the end of the nosing of the southbound on slip road at Junction 7, Rossett Interchange.

iii) The entire lengths of the northbound on slip road and southbound off slip road at Junction 7, Rossett Interchange.

SCHEDULE 2

The length of the northbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 1.8 km south of the nosing of the northbound off slip road at Junction 7, Rossett Interchange to the start of the nosing of the northbound off slip road at Junction 7, Rossett Interchange.
