The A470 Trunk Road (Newbridge-on-Wye, Powys) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2014

Made 19 November 2014

Coming into force 20 November 2014

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the Cardiff – Llangurig Trunk Road (A470) (referred to as “the trunk road”), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 84(1) and (2) and 124 of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Dyfed-Powys Police, make this Order.

Title and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 20 November 2014. The title to this Order is The A470 Trunk Road (Newbridge-on-Wye, Powys) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2014.

Restriction

2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road at Newbridge-on-Wye in the County of Powys that extends from a point 153 metres north of the centre-point of its junction with Cyffredin Lane to a point 250 metres south of the centre-point of its junction with Woodcastle Farm Road.

Revocation

3. The Trunk Road (A470) (Newbridge-On-Wye, Powys) (Restricted Roads) Order 1991(2) is hereby revoked.
