**The A5 & A494 Trunk Roads
(Druid Junction, Druid,
Denbighshire) (Temporary Traffic
Prohibitions & Restrictions) Order
2014**

Made 13 January 2014

Coming into force 20 January 2014

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the London – Holyhead Trunk Road (A5) and the Dolgellau – South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (A494) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk roads”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk roads should be prohibited or restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 20 January 2014 and its title is The A5 & A494 Trunk Roads (Druid Junction, Druid, Denbighshire) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions & Restrictions) Order 2014.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk roads” (“*y darnau o’r cefnffyrdd*”) means:

- i. the length of the A5 trunk road at Druid in the County of Denbighshire that extends from a point 250 metres east of its junction with the A494 to a point 150 metres west of the said junction;
- ii. the length of the A494 trunk road at Druid in the County of Denbighshire that extends from a point 200

metres south of its junction with the A5 to the centre-point of the said junction;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 07:30 hours on 20 January 2014 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions and Restrictions

3. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of the trunk roads.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk roads.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk roads.

6. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the lengths of the trunk roads during such times as the restriction referred to in article 5 is in operation.

Application

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibitions and restrictions referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

8. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 12 months.
