The A487 Trunk Road (Llanon,
Ceredigion) (Temporary Traffic
Restrictions & No Overtaking)
Order 2015

Made *26 March 2015*

Coming into force *1 April 2015*

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Fishguard – Bangor Trunk Road (A487) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 1 April 2015. Its title is The A487 Trunk Road (Llanon, Ceredigion) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2015.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A487 trunk road at Llanon in the County of Ceredigion which extends from a point 300 metres north of the centre-point of its junction with the C1116 in a southerly direction to a point 1.6 kilometres south of the centre-point of its junction with the U1412;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 07:30 hours on 1 April 2015 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition and Restrictions

3. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

6. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road during such times as the restriction referred to in article 5 is in operation.

Suspension

7. The provisions of The Fishguard to Bangor Trunk Road (A487) (Llanon, Ceredigion) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005(3) are hereby suspended in respect of the length of the trunk road during such times as the restrictions specified in articles 4 and 5 are in operation.

Application

8. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein are indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

9. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.
