**The M4 Motorway (Junction 23,
Rogiet to the Wales/England
Border, Monmouthshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)
Order 2015**

Made 2 April 2015

Coming into force 11 April 2015

The Welsh Ministers, as the traffic authority for the London – Fishguard Motorway (M4) (“the motorway”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the motorway should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the motorway.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 11 April 2015. Its title is The M4 Motorway (Junction 23, Rogiet to the Wales/England Border, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2015.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“the length of the motorway” (“*y darn o’r draffordd*”) means the length of the eastbound carriageway of the M4 Motorway which extends from the tip of the nosing of eastbound exit onto the M48 at Junction 23, Rogiet to the Wales/England border

“works period,” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 22.00 hours on 11 April 2015 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any vehicle or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of the motorway.

Application

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
