**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A477 Trunk Road (East  
Williamston to Amroth Road, East  
of Kilgetty, Pembrokeshire)  
(Temporary Speed Restrictions &  
No Overtaking) Order 2015**

*Made* 2 November 2015

*Coming into force* 9 November 2015

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the St Clears – Pembroke Dock Trunk Road (A477) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 9 November 2015 and its title is The A477 Trunk Road (East Williamston to Amroth Road, East of Kilgetty, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Speed Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2015.

**2.—(1)** In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the lengths of the trunk road in the County of Pembrokeshire specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 9 November 2015 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

### **Restrictions & Prohibition**

3. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedules during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

### **Suspensions**

6. The provisions of The Trunk Road (A477) (Kilgetty, Dyfed) (De-Restriction) Order 1991(3) are hereby suspended insofar as they apply to the relevant length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 during such times as the restrictions specified in articles 3 and 4 are in operation and The provisions of The A477 Trunk Road (Broadmoor, Pembrokeshire) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2003(4) are suspended insofar as they apply to the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 during such times as the restriction specified in articles 4 is in operation.

### **Application**

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restrictions and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

8. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

## **SCHEDULES**

### **SCHEDULE 1**

#### **Temporary 40 mph or 10 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking**

The length of the trunk road that extends from the centre-point of its junction with the C3129 Class III road (to East Williamston) to a point 288 metres south west of the centre-point of its junction with the B4586 (to Broadmoor).

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 268 metres north east of the centre-point of its junction with the B4586 to the centre-point of its junction with the C3185 Class III road (Old Amroth Road), including the circulatory carriageway of Kilgetty Roundabout.

### **SCHEDULE 2**

#### **Temporary 10 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking**

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 288 metres south west of the centre-point of its junction with the B4586 (to Broadmoor) to a point 268 metres north east of the centre-point of the said junction.
