The A55 Trunk Road (Eastbound Entry Slip Road at Junction 3 (Caergeiliog), Isle of Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2016

Made 1 November 2016

Coming into force 7 November 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London – Holyhead Trunk Road (A55) ("the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 7 November 2016 and its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Eastbound Entry Slip Road at Junction 3 (Caergeiliog), Isle of Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2016.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services and in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means the entire length of the eastbound entry slip road at Junction 3 (Caergeiliog) on the Isle of Anglesey;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 7 November 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

- **3.** No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to be driven in the length of the trunk road.
- **4.** No person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal cycle in the length of the trunk road.
- **5.** No pedestrian shall, during the works period, proceed in the length of the trunk road.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 6 months.
