Coming into force 8 July 2016

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the Fishguard – Bangor Trunk Road (A487) (“the trunk road”), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 82(2), 83(1) and 124 of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) (“the 1984 Act”) and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for North Wales Police, make this Order.

Title and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 8 July 2016 and its title is The A487 Trunk Road (North & South of Plas Menai Roundabout, Y Felinheli and North & South of Faenol Roundabout, Bangor, Gwynedd) (Derestriction) Order 2016.

Derestriction

2. The lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of section 81 of the 1984 Act.

Revocations

3. The A487 Trunk Road (Port Dinorwic By-Pass, Gwynedd) (De-Restriction) Order 1994(2) and The Trunk Road (A487) (Llanfairisgaer, Gwynedd) (Derestriction) Order 1987 are revoked.

SCHEDULE

1. The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 1,007 metres south-west of the centre-point of Plas Menai Roundabout, Y Felinheli to a point 245 metres north-east of the centre-point of that roundabout.
2. The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 256 metres south-west of the centre-point of the Faenol Roundabout, Bangor to a point 99 metres north-east of the centre-point of that roundabout.
