**The A470 Trunk Road (Llanrwst,
Conwy County Borough)
(Temporary One Way Traffic)
Order 2019**

Made 30 July 2019

Coming into force 3 August 2019

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A470 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A470 Trunk Road (Llanrwst, Conwy County Borough) (Temporary One Way Traffic) Order 2019 and it comes into force on 3 August 2019.

2. In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicles being used by the emergency services; and

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A470 Maentwrog to East of Conwy Trunk Road.

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

Prohibition

3. No person may drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in a southbound direction on the length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with Denbigh Street to its junction with the B5106 (at the southern parapet of Pont Fawr).

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 12 months.
