**The A458 Trunk Road (Broad
Street and High Street, Welshpool,
Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of
Vehicles) Order 2019**

Made 18 September 2019

Coming into force 28 September 2019

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A458 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited due to the Welshpool 1940's Festival being held on or near the roads.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A458 Trunk Road (Broad Street and High Street, Welshpool, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2019 and it comes into force on 28 September 2019.

2. In this Order:

“closure period” (“*y cyfnod cau*”) means that period commencing at 08:00 hours on 28 September 2019 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means:

- (i) any vehicle being used by the emergency services;

(1) 1984 c.27; Section 16A was inserted by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, section 1(1). By virtue of S.I.1999/672, article 2 and Schedule 1, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.27), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

- (ii) any vehicle being used in connection with works to the road or lighting or traffic signs or emergency works to any sewer or to any main or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or telecommunications in, or in any land adjacent to, a length of road concerned; or
- (iii) any vehicle being used by an authorised official in support of and for safety reasons in connection with the Welshpool 1940's Festival Event.

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A458 Shrewsbury to Dolgellau trunk road (Broad Street and High Street) that extends from the junction of Broad Street with Church Street, Berriew Street and Severn Street to the junction of High Street with Jehu Road.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the closure period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 2 days.
