**The A483 Trunk Road (Broad
Street & High Street, Builth Wells,
Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of
Vehicles) Order 2020**

Made 22 September 2020

Coming into force 28 September 2020

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A483 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾, make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A483 Trunk Road (Broad Street & High Street, Builth Wells, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 28 September 2020.

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A483 Swansea to Manchester trunk road known as Broad Street and High Street, Builth

Wells, Powys that extends from a point 10 metres west of its junction with the A470 Castle Street to a point 3 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with Strand Street;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 19:00 hours on 28 September 2020 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Suspension

5. The provisions of article 4 of the Trunk Road (A483) (Builth Wells, Powys) (One Way Traffic) Order 1983(2) are suspended in respect of the length of the trunk road known as The Strand during such times as the prohibition specified in article 3 of this Order is in operation.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
