**The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 19
(Glan Conwy Interchange), Conwy
County Borough) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2021**

Made 5 January 2021

Coming into force 8 January 2021

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A55 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A55 Trunk Road (Junction 19 (Glan Conwy Interchange), Conwy County Borough) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2021 and it comes into force on 8 January 2021.

2. In this Order—

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A55 Chester to Bangor trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 19:00 hours on 8 January 2021 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the lengths of the main eastbound and westbound carriageways of the trunk road at Junction 19 (Glan Conwy Interchange) that extend from the nosing of the exit slip roads to the nosing of the entry slip roads.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only at such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
