**The A494 Trunk Road (High Street,
Bala, Gwynedd) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2022**

Made 7 November 2022

Coming into force 13 November 2022

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A494 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of a relevant event, namely the Remembrance Sunday memorial service, being held on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A494 Trunk Road (High Street, Bala, Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2022 and this Order comes into force on 13 November 2022.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“event period” (“*cyfnod y digwyddiad*”) means that period commencing at 10:40 hours on 13 November 2022 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are removed;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672 and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these functions are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means:

- (i) any vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance services purposes;
- (ii) any vehicle being used in connection with works to the road or lighting or traffic signs or emergency works to any sewer or to any main or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or telecommunications in, or in any land adjacent to, a length of road concerned;
- (iii) any vehicle used by an authorised event official in support of and for reasons of the safety of the relevant event;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A494 Dolgellau to south of Birkenhead trunk road.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the event period, cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed on the length of the trunk road known as High Street that extends from the centre-point of its junction with Aran Street to the centre-point of its junction with Mount Street at Bala, Gwynedd.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 1 day.
