ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 10 (Caernarfon Road Interchange) to Junction 9 (Treborth Interchange), Bangor, Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2022

Made 16 September 2022

Coming into force 24 September 2022

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A55 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A55 Trunk Road (Junction 10 (Caernarfon Road Interchange) to Junction 9 (Treborth Interchange), Bangor, Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2022 and this Order comes into force on 24 September 2022.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

(1) 1984 c. 27; section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c. 26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1. By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempti*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A55 London to Holyhead trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 19:00 hours on 24 September 2022 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order on the length of the trunk road.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

5. No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians

1. The length of the westbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from the nosing of the westbound exit slip road of Junction 10 (Caernarfon Road Interchange) to the nosing of the westbound entry slip road of Junction 9 (Treborth Interchange).
2. The length of the westbound entry slip road at Junction 10 (Caernarfon Road Interchange).
3. The length of the westbound exit slip road at Junction 9 (Treborth Interchange).
