**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A40 Trunk Road (Abergavenny  
to Raglan, Monmouthshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)  
Order 2024

*Made* 26 November 2024

*Coming into force* 2 December 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the A40 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted and/or prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(1)</sup>, make this Order.

**Title and commencement**

1. The title of this Order is the A40 Trunk Road (Abergavenny to Raglan, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 2 December 2024.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y cefnffyrdd*”) means the lengths of the A40 Raglan to Llandovery Trunk Road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 20:00 hours on 2 December 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

### **Prohibition**

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

### **Application**

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 12 months.

## **SCHEDULE**

The length of the eastbound A40 that extends from the Hardwick Roundabout, Abergavenny to the western side of Raglan Roundabout, Raglan.

The length of the eastbound A40 that extends from the eastern side of Raglan Roundabout, Raglan to the crossing connecting Monmouth Road with Groesenon Road.
