**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A40 Trunk Road (Nantyffin to  
Brynich Roundabout, Brecon,  
Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of  
Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians)  
Order 2024

*Made* 3 June 2024

*Coming into force* 10 June 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A40 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

**Title and commencement**

1. The title of this Order is the A40 Trunk Road (Nantyffin to Brynich Roundabout, Brecon, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 10 June 2024.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in

connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A40 Raglan to Llandoverly trunk road that extends from its junction with the A479 at Nantyffin to its junction with Brynich Roundabout, Brecon in the County of Powys;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 00:01 hours on 10 June 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

### **Prohibitions**

**3.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road.

**4.** No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road.

**5.** No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the length of the trunk road.

### **Application**

**6.** The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

**7.** The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
