ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A40 Trunk Road (High Street, Fishguard, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024

Made 7 October 2024

Coming into force 14 October 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A40 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A40 Trunk Road (High Street, Fishguard, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 14 October 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the length of the A40 London to Fishguard trunk road that extends from a point outside number 2 High Street to a point outside number 23 High Street, Fishguard, Pembrokeshire;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 08:00 hours on 14 October 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 12 months.
